



<u>Thank you</u> to all the parishioners, the Knights of Columbus and all the other organizations for their support of SVDP by generously donating food and financial assistance so we could offer help to Franklin residents in need. Special thanks to Fathers Brian, Bob, Jack, Deacon Ron, and Deacon Guy for spreading God's message of the importance of helping others.

Our 38 members volunteered almost 5,600 hours meeting with families in need, a total of 1,076 times, with 2,674 people helped. In 2023 we have continued our mission of providing assistance to neighbors in need. We are back to doing home visits with people as Covid has ended. Two members meet with neighbors in need and do an intake to assess how best to help. Any financial assistance is paid directly to the provider of services and not to the person seeking assistance.

Your support helped us:

- Distribute 675 bags of donated food & 105 personal hygiene bags
- Give out 72 Complimentary SVDP Thrift Store vouchers worth \$3,600
- Caring Tree 98 families / 224 people with Gifts cards of \$9,500
- Provide Gifts for Mother's Day (48), Father's Day (13) and Veterans (6) of \$2,600

Financially, your donations served families 319 times for a total over \$ 64,000

- Housing assistance 43 times for \$33,800
- Utilities 34 times for \$10,900
- Automobile related assistance 12 times for \$5.000
- Easter Meal Food Cards 71 families for \$3,600
- Grocery store, Gas & Other gift cards 115 times for \$3,500
- Furniture 14 times for \$3,300
- Other: Medical, Child Care, and Moving 30 times for \$4,100

We continue to have strong relationships with other town organizations and businesses. We gave families 200 referrals to town, state and federal agencies that might help them.

In the coming year neighbors in need face significant **challenges** due to increases for housing, utilities, food & gas. These costs put added pressure on them to make ends meet.

The most important members of this Ministry are each of you, our Contributing members, without whom we would not be able to serve. We thank you for your generosity, and want you to know your contributions are very appreciated by the people we serve.

Deacon Guy continues a Zoom Rosary every Monday night at




