**Catechetical Sunday**

Today, September 15, is Catechetical Sunday here in the United States. This year's theme is "**Lord, when did we see you hungry**", a quote from Chapter 25 of Matthew's gospel. (<https://bit.ly/Hunger2024>.)

As Catholics, we are called to put our faith into action, inviting others to share our faith in Jesus Christ. **Year of Prayer**

In his twenty-eighth teaching on prayer, Pope Francis reminds us that we are always surrounded by that "cloud of witnesses" (*Heb 12:1*), the saints.

The pope says that a saint is a "man or woman who encountered Jesus and followed Jesus." Saints bring us to Jesus and show us that we, too, can be holy. Pope Francis tells us that there is a "mysterious solidarity" in Christ, that there is connection between those believers who have gone before us and those of us who are pilgrims in this life. The pope, referencing the Catechism, encourages us to pray to the saints, asking them to intercede for us and for the whole world. <https://bit.ly/PFPrayer28>



### The Season of Creation

September 2024 is The Season of Creation Month. We will feature passages from Pope Francis' 2015 environmental encyclical *Laudato Si*.

Creation is the subject of this week's passage: "In the Judaeo-Christian tradition, the word "creation" has a broader meaning than "nature," for it has to do with God's loving plan in which every creature has its own value and significance. *Nature* is usually seen as a system which can be studied, understood and controlled, whereas *creation* can only be understood as a gift from the outstretched hand of the Father of all, and as a reality illuminated by the love which calls us together into universal communion."

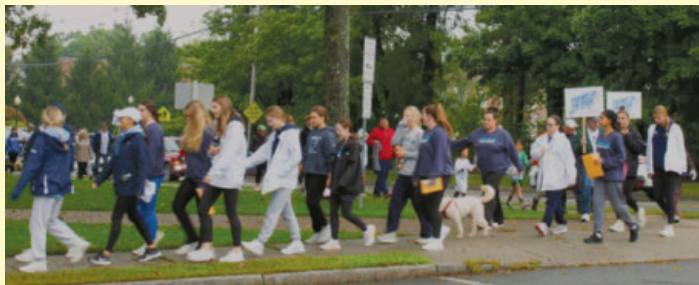

## Bible Study Group

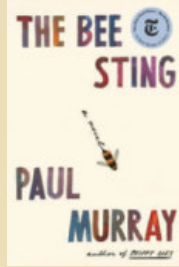

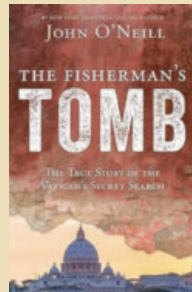


## Book Club

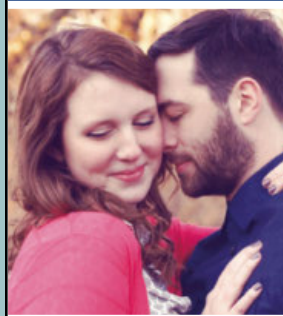
