


If it rains, the Rosary Rally will be in the Chapel.






Year of Prayer

This week, Pope Francis discusses the "Our Father," a vocal prayer Jesus taught to his disciples and which we still pray today.

The pope tells us that the "prayer of the lips that is whispered or recited together, is always accessible, and is as necessary as manual labor." He says that it is "like an anchor where one can hold on to the rope and remain, faithful, come what may." Pope Francis warns against the pride of scorning all vocal prayer in favor of meditation or mental prayer. He reminds us that "the words we speak take us by the hand; at times they restore flavor, they awaken even the sleepiest of hearts; they reawaken feelings we had forgotten." 


