

# Year of Prayer

The struggle of prayer is the topic of Pope Francis' thirty-third teaching on prayer. The pope tells us that prayer "is not something easy, and this is why we flee from it." He cites distraction as one of the enemies of prayer and then tells us that the Catechism names other enemies like discouragement, disappointment about not being heard according to our will, and our resistance to the idea that prayer itself is a gift.


# Palliative Care Presentation

Hosted by the St. Mary Respect Life Commission. This presentation will also be available on Zoom.




# Have you Made your Appointment to Donate Blood?

# CORI Weekend October 26 & 27

Next weekend, October 26/27, is CORI collection weekend here at St. Mary's Parish. Every fiscal year, it is our parish policy, following Archdiocesan requirements, to collect signed and completed CORI release forms from all of our employees and volunteers every fiscal year. If you are volunteer, part of a parish organization or council, belong to the St. Vincent de Paul teach Religious Ed. or coach, a pastoral visitor, or minister at Mass, coach, you are required to complete a CORI form this year.

CORI forms are available to complete and sign <u>after all Masses next weekend</u> in the Sacred Heart Hall. Please remember to bring your driver's license (or other form of government-issued ID) with you, as you will need this to complete the form.

You can also print and complete the form ahead of time and have your signature verified (driver's license or other form of government-issued ID needed) after Mass on the CORI collection dates.
