



Year of Prayer

"Perseverance in love" is the name of Pope Francis' 37th teaching on prayer. Pope Francis reminds us that St. Paul urges us to "*Pray constantly, always*"

and for everything, give thanks." The Pope knows that it is not easy, but he encourages us to keep the fire of love and prayer, and thus of Christian life, continuously burning in our hearts, even in the midst of life's work.

He says that there is "circularity" between faith, life and prayer which helps to keep alive "that flame of Christian love that God expects of us." Pope Francis reminds us that we can pray a simple prayer as we work: "Lord, Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner!" https://bit.ly/PFPrayer37.

St. Mary's Book Club's next meeting will be December 5th from 6:00 - 7:00 pm. No assigned book. Instead, we will have a Christmas Yankee




