

Year of Prayer

Pope Francis ends his series of teachings on prayer with this, his 38th teaching. In this teaching, *The Paschal Prayer of Jesus for Us*, the pope tells us that Jesus prayed a lot. "Jesus immersed himself in

it [prayer] because dialogue with the Father was the incandescent core of his entire existence." Jesus even prayed during the days of his Passover, praying at the Last Supper, during his agony in the garden and on the cross. Pope Francis says that "Jesus' prayer is intense; Jesus' prayer is unique, and it also becomes the model for our prayer."

Finally, the Pope reminds us that Jesus has prayed for us, and has "welcomed us into the dialogue with his Father, in communion with the Holy Spirit." https://bit.ly/PFPrayer38


Vatican II Document on the Church

Lumen Gentium (LG) is the Vatican II document on the Church was promulgated on November 21, 1964 and is marking its sixtieth anniversary this month. Some of LG's significant points are A) the Church is both a "sign and instrument" of God's relationship with the human race, and it is the "seed and beginning" of God's kingdom here on earth. B) the laity have the job of ensuring that the goods of the world are developed for all people in an equitable fashion, thus making their own "contribution to universal progress in human and Christian liberty," and C) all in the Church are called to holiness, regardless of their role in life, each person working to "steadfastly advance along the way of a living faith which arouses hope and works through love."
