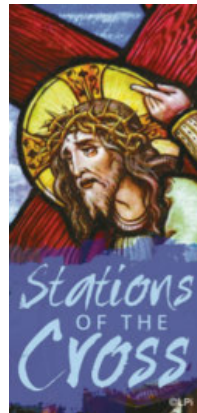
**Support the Church Around the World**

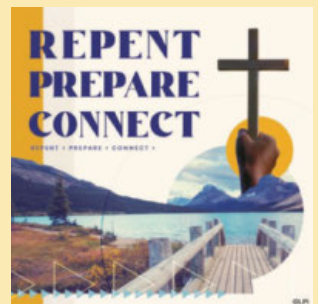


**Weekly Lenten Prayer Service**

Lent is nearly here. Beginning on Ash Wednesday, March 5, Lent reminds us that we belong to God and are called to be reconciled to him and live in his ways.

During the six Wednesdays of Lent, our parish will celebrate Evening Prayer, along with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the opportunity for individual confession (Sacrament of Reconciliation). The Prayer services are on Wednesday's from 7:00pm - 8:00pm, and will run from March 12 through April 16 in the Chapel. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place at 7:00pm, followed by Evening Prayer.

Evening Prayer is one facet of the Liturgy of the Hours, the Church's official daily prayer. It consists of psalms and canticles, prayers, petitions, a reading and songs. Following this prayer, participants will have the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. A simple Benediction just before 8:00pm will complete the service. Join us for some quiet, reflective time during this season of Lent.



Fasting was practiced by righteous men and women of the Old Testament and later by Christ himself. It remains an important part of the Christian devotional life today, being most strongly associated with the penitential season of Lent.



The practice of fasting predates Christianity. The Old Testament is full of examples of righteous men and women mortifying their flesh for the purpose of making atonement or to grow closer to God. Jesus himself fasted for forty days and forty nights in preparation for the beginning of his public ministry, and we see his disciples following his example in the Acts of the Apostles.

Fasting continues to be an important part of Christian devotional life today. Many people feel the practice of fasting enhances their prayer and helps them fulfill St. Paul's advice to "put to death the deeds of the body" (Romans 8:13) to grow in the Spirit. Most Catholics will associate fasting with the liturgical season of Lent, which begins and ends with obligatory fasting for all members of the Latin Catholic Church between ages 18 and 59. ©LPi

So, what does the Jubilee Year mean for us here in Franklin? First of all, you can visit the US Bishops' Jubilee webpage ([www.usccb.org/jubilee2025](http://www.usccb.org/jubilee2025)) where you will

find a link to a brief introductory video about the Jubilee. The video includes a note about how we can participate in the Jubilee without going to Rome.

In the pope's introductory Jubilee decree, he mentioned groups of people who are especially in need of hope in our time: prisoners, the young, the elderly, the poor. Here at home, we can perform acts of mercy in service of one or more of these groups. For instance, Word Among Us Partners ([www://waupartners.org/](http://www://waupartners.org/)) and the Bethany House Ministries in Millis ([www:bethanyhouseministries.org/](http://www:bethanyhouseministries.org/)) offer ways to minister to those imprisoned.

Here in our parish, the St. Mary's Society of St. Vincent de Paul provides many opportunities to give assistance to the poor. In this Jubilee Year, you can also take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation offered here at St. Mary or make a "pilgrimage" to Fatima Shrine in Holliston. Finally, the focus of a Jubilee Year is on renewal of our relationships with God and with one another. Whatever we can do to enhance one or both of these relationships will be a sign of hope for our fellow pilgrims.
