

Catholic Social Teaching

The US Bishops, in their 2011 document: *Sharing Catholic Social Teaching: Challenges and Directions*, tell us that "the social teaching of the Church is an essential part of Catholic faith." As we understand and incorporate the social teaching of the Church in our lives, we enhance our "capacity to be a Church that is true to the demands of the Gospel."

We are reminded by the bishops that Catholic Social Teaching (CST) has its roots in the call of the prophets "who announced God's special love for the poor and called God's people to a covenant of love and justice." CST is further developed and seen in Jesus' own teachings and actions, as he identified himself with the poor and marginalized in his society. Over the next few months, we will look at the seven themes of CST, seeking to know a little more about these basic tenets of our faith and growing our capacity to be Church.
