






LIFE AND DIGNITY OF THE PERSON

The first Catholic Social Teaching theme that we will address is the **Life and Dignity of the Human Person**. This theme can be viewed as the foundation of all of Catholic social thought. It is very spiritual/religious in nature, as it focuses on the fact that God created us with dignity, worth and value. It is intrinsic to who we are; God created us in his image.

In Sharing Catholic Social Teaching: Challenges and Directions, the US bishops write that "when we pray, 'Thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven,' we are praying for God's kingdom of justice and peace and committing ourselves to breaking down the barriers that obstruct God's kingdom of justice and peace and to working to bring about a world more respectful of human life and dignity." Some of the phrases we hear in relationship to this theme are "respect life from womb to tomb" or "respect life from conception to natural death." This teaching is also referred to as a "consistent ethic of life" or a "seamless garment." You can watch a short video on this first CST theme at https://bit.ly/USCCBcrs.
