Decree on the Apostolate of Lay People

Apostolicam actuositatem is the Second Vatican Council's Decree on the Apostolate of Lay People. It tells us that, by virtue of our baptism, every lay person is brought into the Church and is called to share in the Church's mission of bringing all people to Christ.

We are reminded that the laity "accomplish the church's mission in the world principally by that binding of behavior and faith which makes them the light of the world. The laity are asked to have a strong spiritual life, grounded in sound doctrine and motivated by faith, hope, and charity. We must strive to be professionally competent, working for the common good, and modeling Christian family and societal values and virtues as part of being a witness to Christ in the world.

In addition, lay people are encouraged by the bishops to participate in ongoing education and formation, both spiritual and human; there's always something to learn!
